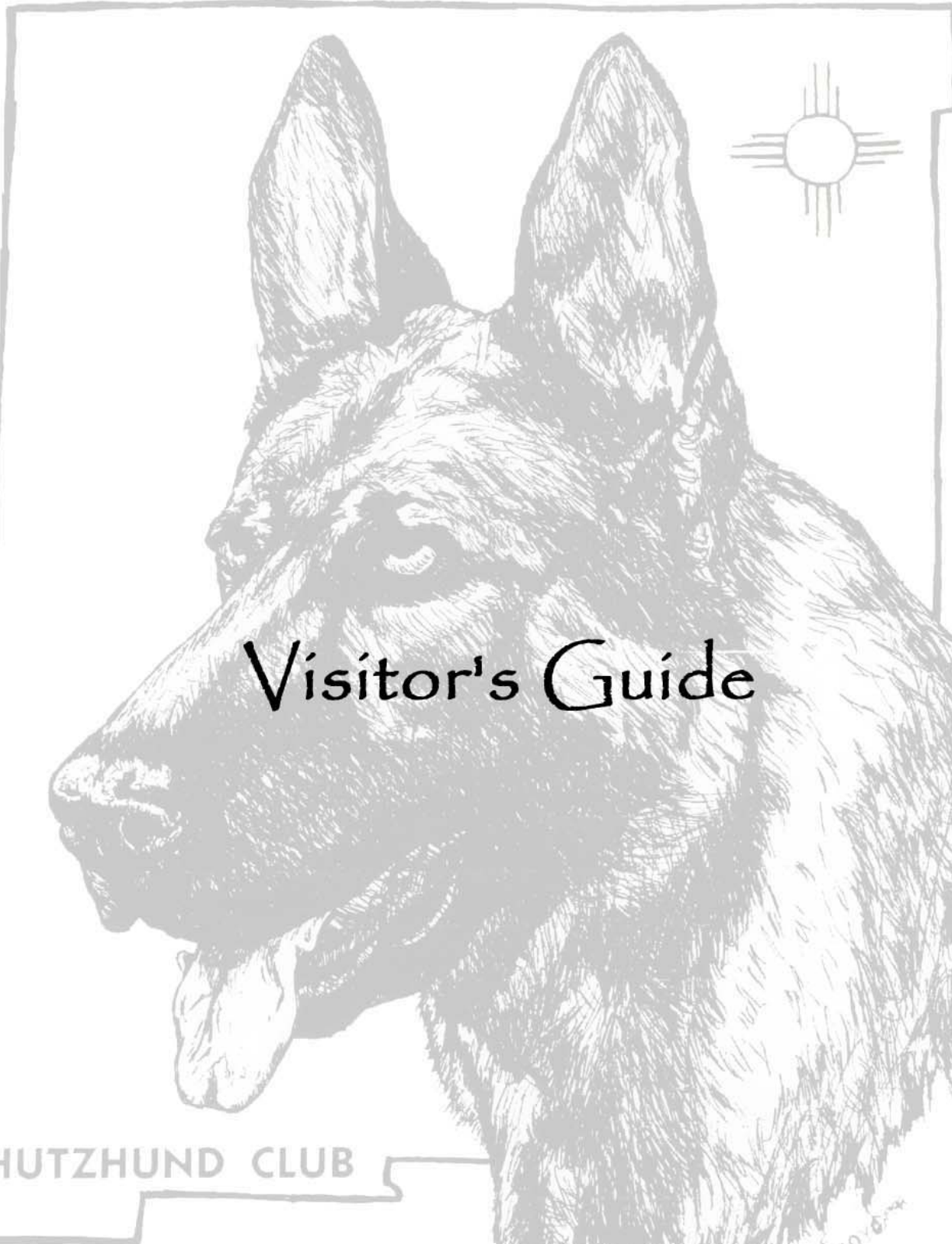

Albuquerque Overview

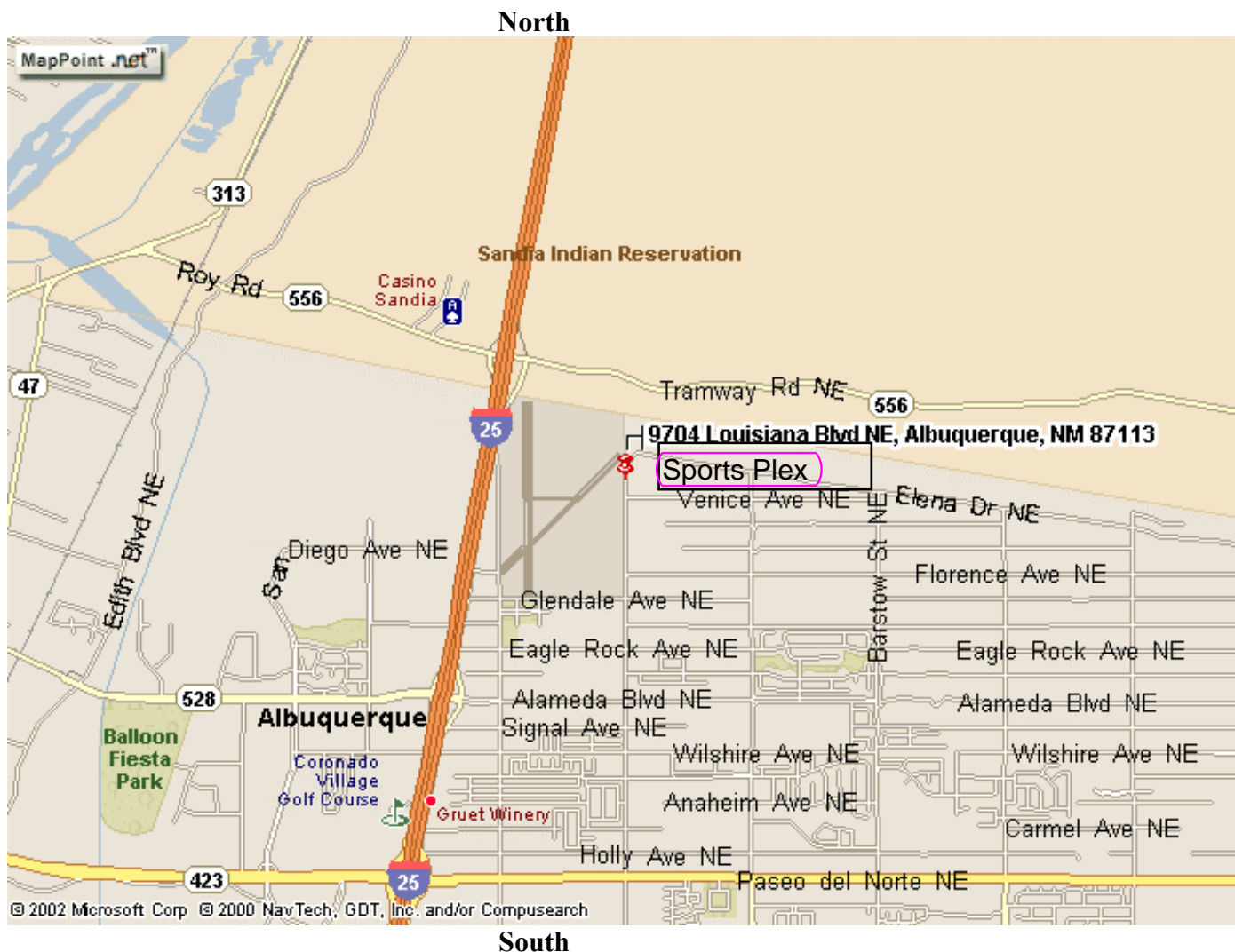
Welcome to Albuquerque! This is just a little brief overview of how Albuquerque is laid out; this will help those of you that have never been to Albuquerque before.

Albuquerque is pretty much just one big square grid. Most major streets will run North/Side and East West without too much funky stuff going on. It's extremely hard to get lost in Albuquerque – just remember that the mountains are the East side. All the hotels that we have listed in this brochure are located on the far North end of town. You will find a large variety of restaurants, a hospital, pet supplies, and an emergency vet hospital all in this general vicinity.

Just about everything listed will be off the San Mateo Blvd., area (south of the hotels listed). However, we have added some places that are a little out of the way but well worth the trip. The addresses will decrease as you head South and increase as you head East. **Reference map shown below – the pin on the map is 5600 San Mateo**



Field Location



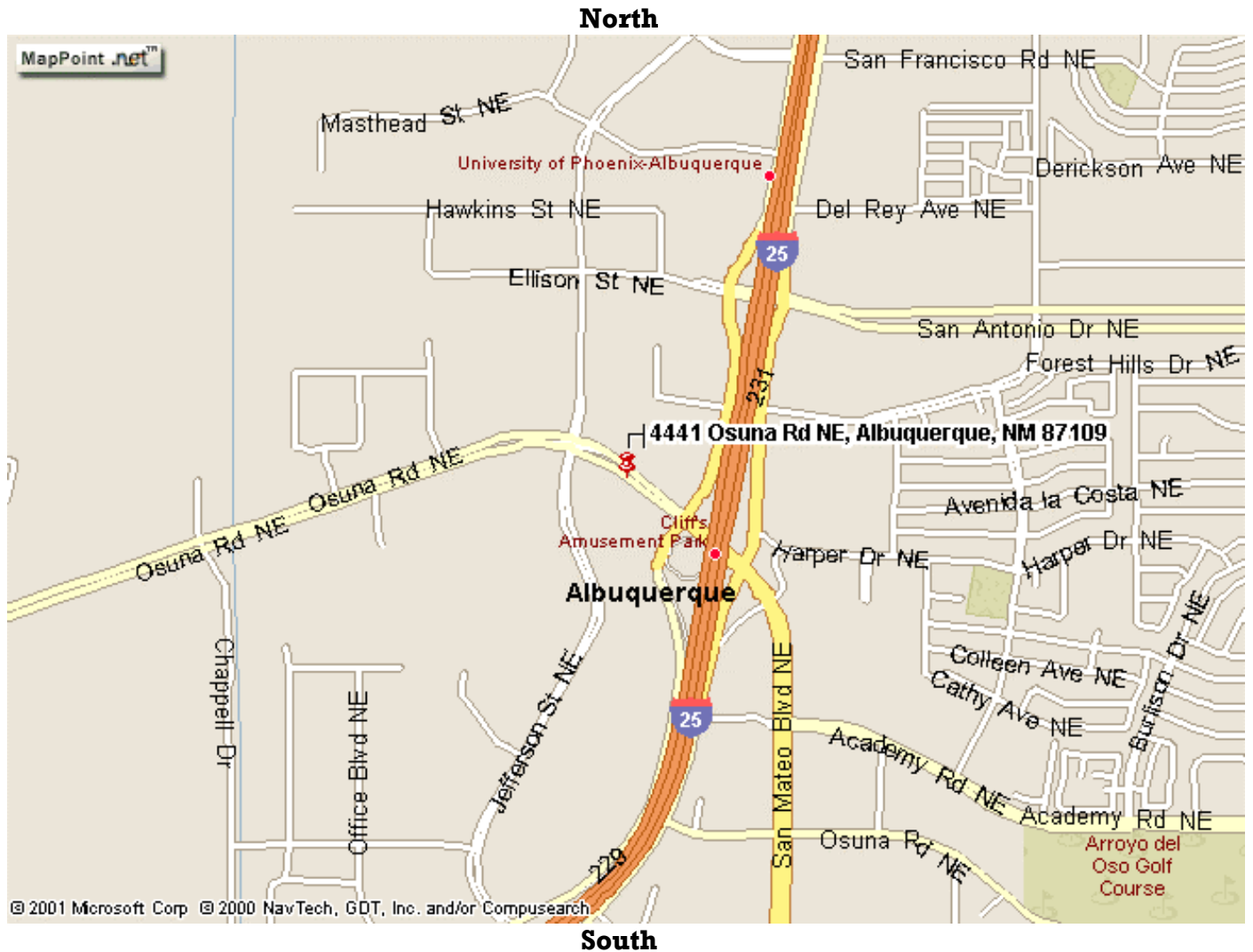
Directions: I-25 North – Exit Paseo del Norte heading East. (*Paseo del Norte will be North of all the hotels that we have listed.*) At the second traffic light “Louisiana” turn left. You will see the softball fields on your right hand side at the end of Louisiana – Turn left on Beverly Hills – at the end of the softball fields (where the chain link ends) turn Right and go around to the gate opening for the soccer field

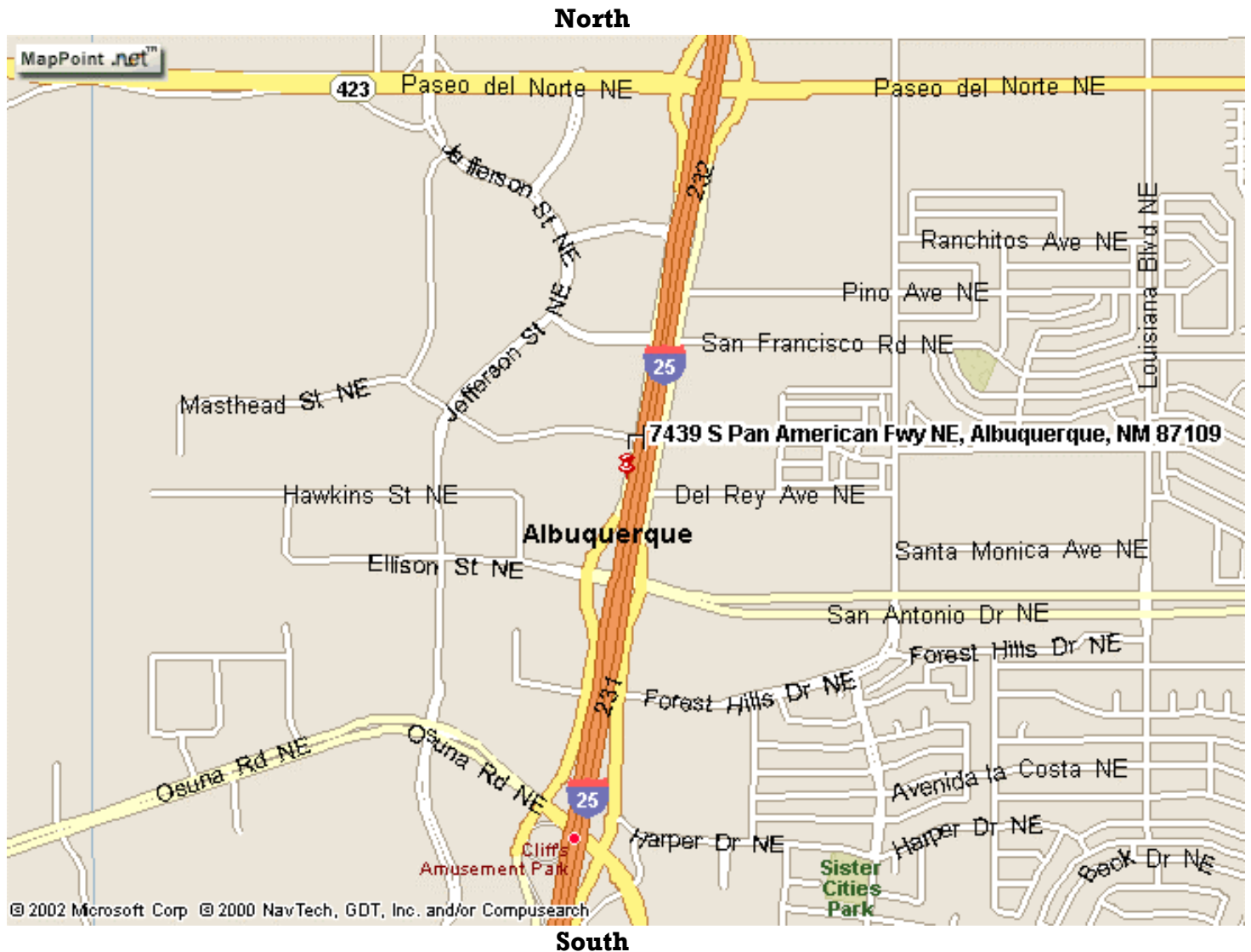

Directions: From I-25 turn West onto Osuna (San Mateo/Osuna exit). The hotel is less than ½ mile from I-25 on the North side of Osuna

Note: Pan American Fwy is on both side of the highway. However, they are only “One Way” streets. So, if you’re heading North you want to be on the East side of the highway. If you’re heading South you need to be on the West side of the highway.

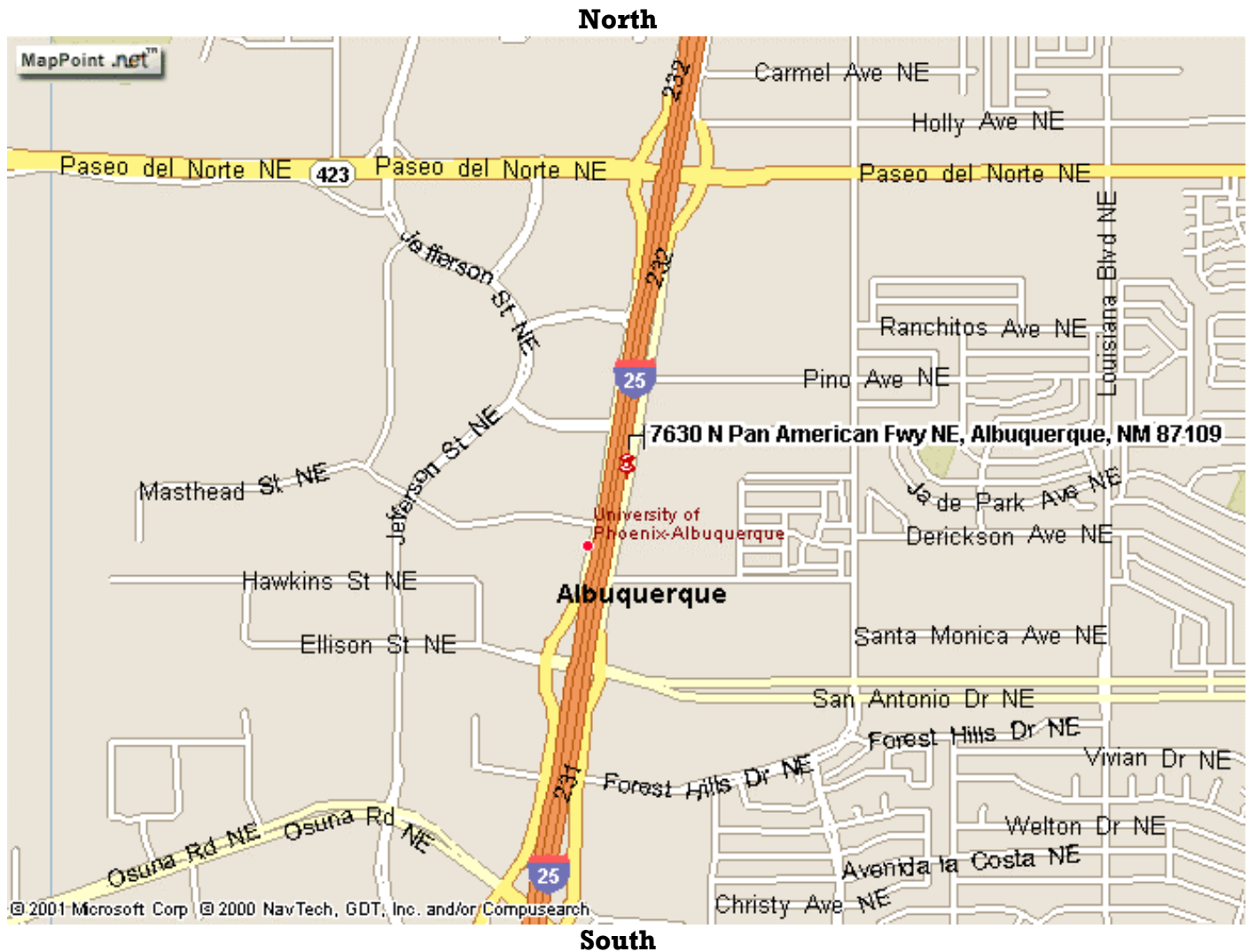

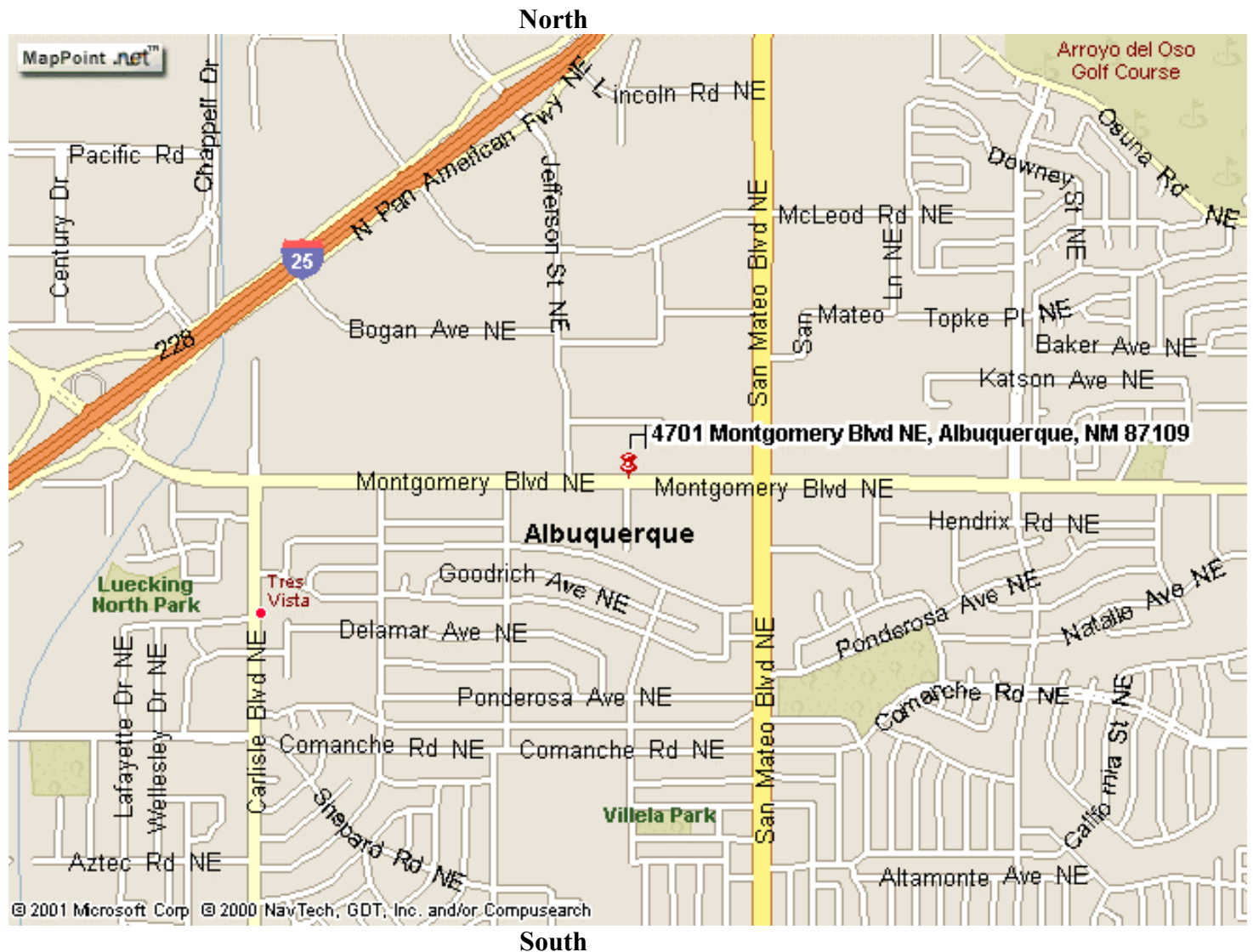

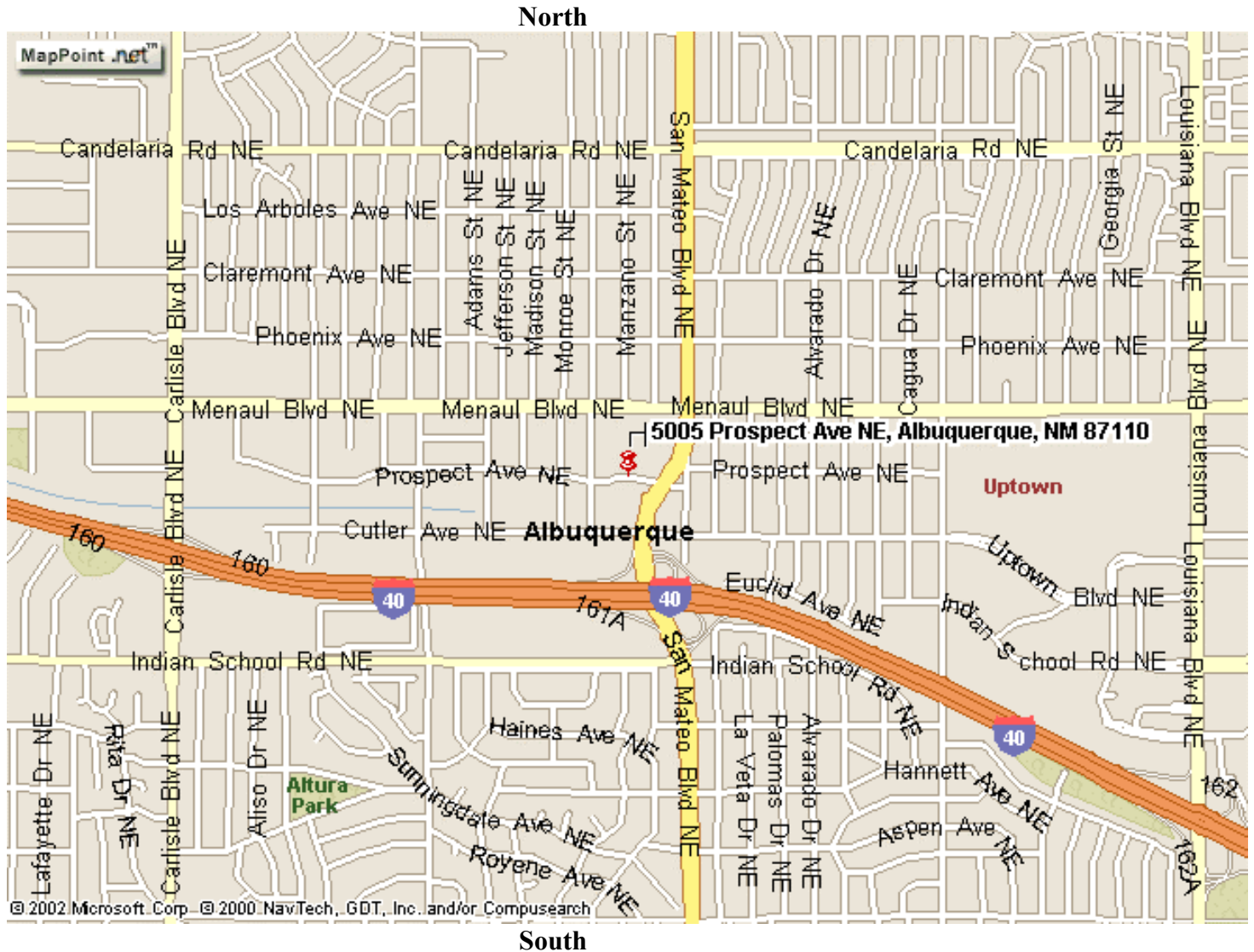
Directions: South on San Mateo to Montgomery Blvd. turn West (right). Located on North Side of Montgomery about a block from San Mateo.

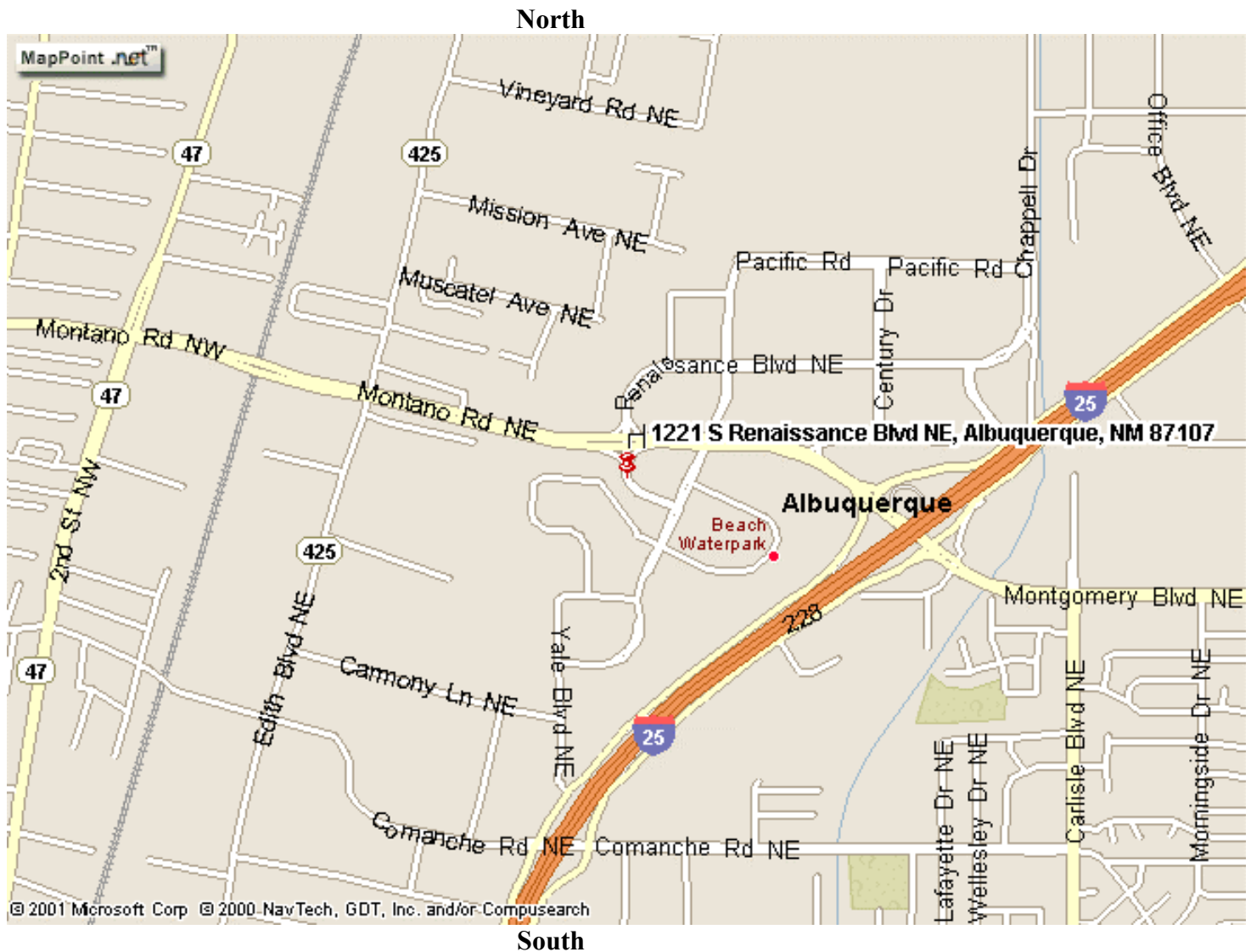

You can also get there by going straight up Paseo del Norte and turning South on Tramway, turn left on Indian School. However, there are a lot of Traffic lights with this route.

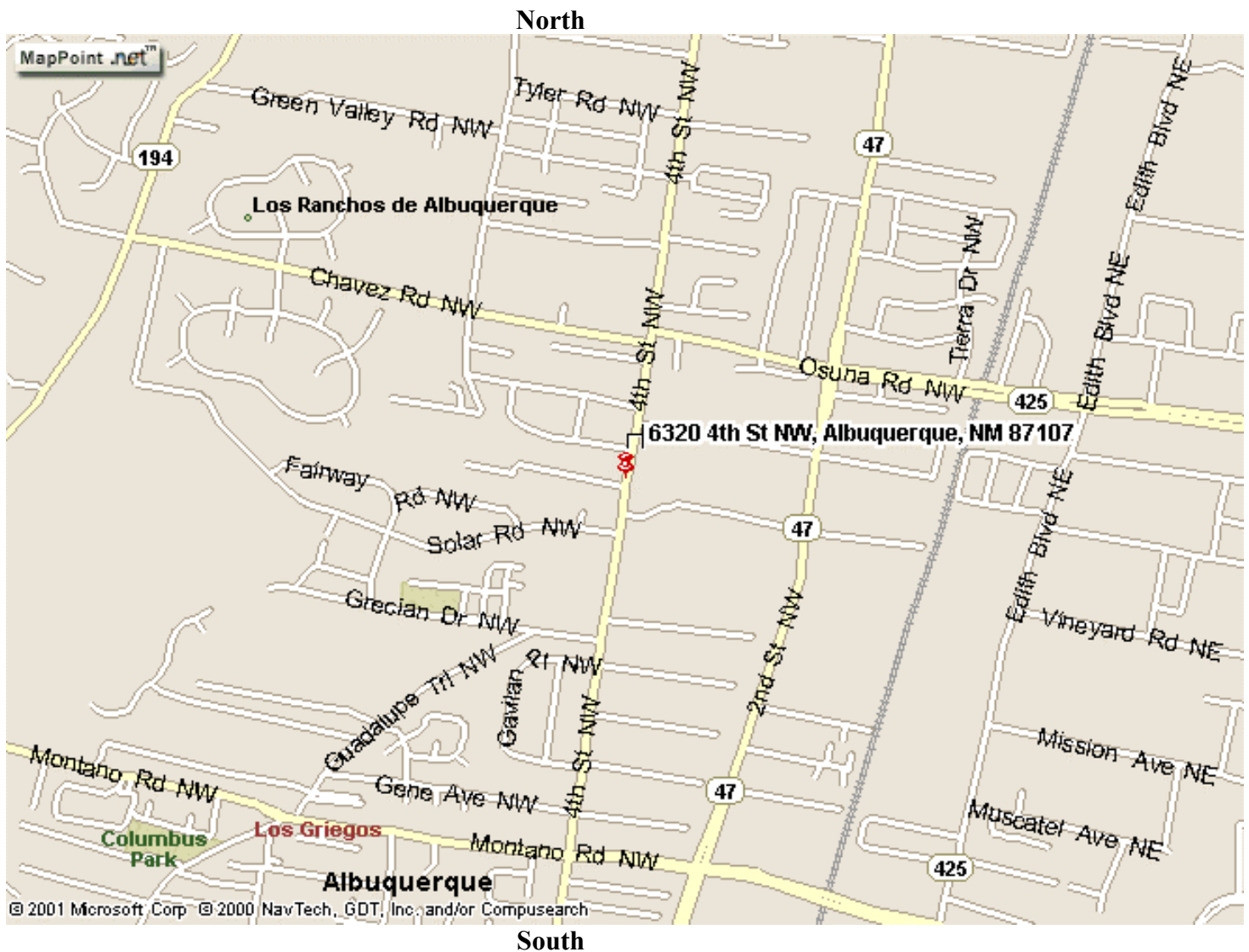

Directions: From I-25 take Montgomery heading West or Osuna heading West. (Montgomery will turn into Montano at some point) Turn Right on 4th Street (applies to both Montano and Osuna) Turn right at Solar (traffic light) there is a Giant gas station right on the corner.

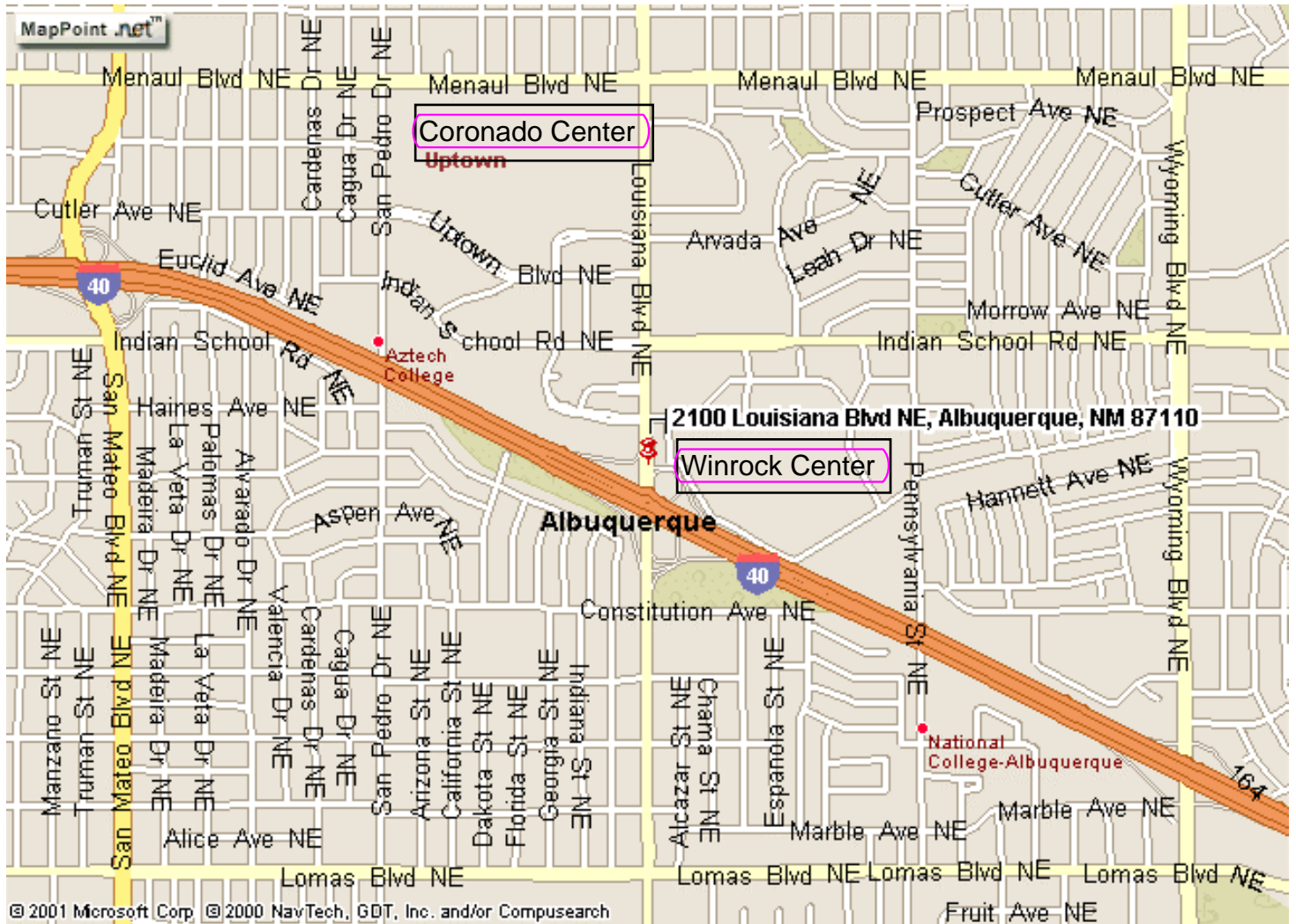
